SUBJECT: United States Army Garrison Kaiserslautern (USAGK) Command Policy Letter #20-  
Command Involvement in the Family Case Review Committee (CRC)

1. Reference: Army Regulation 608-18, Army Family Advocacy Program, 30 October 2007.
2. Purpose: This memorandum establishes the policy for the involvement of unit Commanders who play a key role in the Army's efforts to reduce family violence.
3. Commanders are responsible for ensuring that Soldiers and family members involved in family violence are restored to a healthy state. A significant part of this responsibility is participation in the CRC.
4. The Commander or First Sergeant should attend the CRC. In the event a Soldier under your command has a case to be brought to CRC, Social Work Services will inform you of the date, time and place of the CRC meeting.
5. Your personal attention to these actions is needed to help mitigate the cycle of family violence in the USAGK military community and throughout the US Army in Europe.
